Dear Sir/Madam:

Our office represents the Military Religious Freedom Foundation and its Founder and President, Mikey Weinstein.

Mr. Weinstein has called to our attention that your organization has published, on the Internet, an interactive-type map, purporting to identify "anti-Christian" organizations.

For reasons that I can't fathom, your map, apparently of the Albuquerque area, identifies the Military Religious Freedom Foundation as an "anti-Christian organization." The Foundation is not "anti-Christian." In fact, most of its clients are in fact self identified Christians.

I don't know what would possess your organization to publish such a thing on the Internet, but inaccurately identifying the Foundation in this context is inexcusable. By this letter, we demand that you take down the reference to the Foundation on your map immediately.

Please understand that as a consequence of your map, someone identifying themselves as one of your members has already repeatedly sent threatening communications to the Foundation. As this type of problem often requires intervention by law enforcement authorities we would ask that you take down the reference on your site to the Foundation immediately before things get worse than they already are.

Have you not learned anything from what has been reported almost non-stop recently about the potential harmful effect of postings on the Internet inciting unstable people to acts of violence? You may think it is "cute" to make false statements about individuals or organizations who do not



subscribe to your particular brand of Christianity but it is not at all funny when people are subjected to threats and the risks of violent acts as a consequence.

Please also ask your legal counsel to contact us immediately so that we can discuss the matter. We have the name of the individual in Indiana who is apparently one of your members and we would like to put that information in the hands of your lawyer so that he in turn can coordinate with law enforcement authorities to determine how best to deal with the dangerous situation you have created.
